Personal, Social and Emotional Development

- Work as part of a group. Play a variety of literacy and numeracy games sharing and cooperating and taking turns.
- Consider the consequences of their words and actions, understand it is important to respect each other and be kind. Discussion on how we show kindness towards each other.



Communication, Language and Literacy

- Hear and say sounds in the order they occur. Letter and Sounds ng reinforcement ng spelling and reading.
- Retell the story of Bernadette in Lourdes together, sequencing the story correctly.
- Form recognisable letters form a-z correctly. Prep to follow.



Problem Solving, Reasoning & Numeracy

- Learn to count in a variety of ways 1-50 backwards from a variety of numbers. 2's to 20. 10's to 100. Find 1/2/3 less. Develop mental capabilities when taking away.
- Begin to relate subtraction to taking away, understand the vocabulary of subtraction and begin to record work.
- Learn to describe and name solid shapes.



Knowledge and Understanding of the World

- Begin to know about own culture.
- Valentine's Day know why people give each other cards and presents. Make a heart.



Creative Development

- Explore colours and texture, Valentine's Day painting and collage. Know how to make colour darker, colour mixing dark to light.
- Respond to what they see, snowdrop observational, pastel drawings.



Physical Development
